- 6. Lead/Asbestos There are no items or materials that contain lead or asbestos associated with this work on site.
- Other Onsite work Contractor is hereby made aware that work by Kiewit may be occurring during the outage project. SRA will coordinate the work between both projects to minimize conflicts.
