Job Title: Canal Crewman

Duties and Responsibilities:

- Have ability to do manual work as required: operating chain saw, weedeater, mowing equipment, using shovel, packer, trimmer, any other work required to complete assignment.
- Have ability to operate mobile radio system.
- Ability to swim.
- Ability to walk long distances.
- Ability to safely lift, carry and handle supplies and equipment weighing at least 75 pounds or more if required.
- Have dependable transportation.
- Ability to wear safety-toed footwear.
- Have ability to climb and work on ladders.
- Have the physical ability to work outdoors most of the time, often under adverse terrain conditions and exposure to such typical climatic environmental conditions as heat, cold, poison ivy and poison oak, snakes and insects.

Educational, Experience, and Other Job Requirements:

- Should be a high school graduate or GED equivalent.
- Must have one year of experience in the operation of heavy equipment or mechanical aptitude which indicates the ability to learn the operation of heavy equipment.
- Must be able to understand and follow oral and written instructions in English.
- Must have a valid State of Texas driver's license and be insurable under the Authority's automobile insurance policy.
- Have knowledge & experience with computer software Microsoft Word & Excel
