Holiday Recreation Area on Lake Tawakoni Reservoir

(Lake Tawakoni Reservoir, Texas) The Sabine River Authority of Texas (SRA) recently opened the Holiday Recreation Area on Lake Tawakoni. The facility is located along Highway 47 in Van Zandt County near the west end of the Iron Bridge Dam.

The new Holiday Recreation Area includes a pavilion, three-lane boat ramp, and public parking, to accommodate local and national fishing tournaments, community gatherings and recreation

enthusiasts on Lake Tawakoni Reservoir. The opening marks completion of the initial development with future phases currently under consideration.

David Montagne, Executive Vice President and General Manager of the Sabine River Authority of Texas said, "We are excited to open this first-class facility on Lake Tawakoni for the public to enjoy. Holiday Recreation Area is part of SRA's economic development program to enhance recreational opportunities throughout the Sabine River Basin, fulfilling SRA's obligation to assist in the development of the Basin."

Created by the Legislature in 1949, the Sabine River Authority of Texas is an official agency of the State of Texas. The Authority was created as a conservation and reclamation district with responsibilities to control, store, preserve, and distribute the waters of the Sabine River and its tributary streams for useful purposes.
