The Sabine River Authority of Texas (SRA) is seeking bids for the purchase of rip rap in the proposed location on Toledo Bend. Sealed bids are to be received in the office of the Division Manager, Sabine River Authority of Texas (SRA) Toledo Bend Division Office at 450 Spur 135 Burkeville, TX, 75932 for response to this request for bid, until 2:00 p.m. THURSDAY, July 06, 2023. Bids will, immediately thereafter, be publicly opened and read aloud.

PRE BID MEETING - Clarifications:

The following questions were reviewed at the Pre Bid Meeting. Responses are in italic following each question.

- Does the contractor need to furnish equipment to unload the quarry stone? SRA will provide
 the equipment to offload the quarry stone at the Pendleton site. Contractor to coordinate
 with SRA 1 week ahead of delivery for equipment to be on site.
- When are the delivery hours for rock rip rap? *Typical hours are 7 am to 5 pm Monday Friday.*
- Who pays for hardness testing? *The contractor is responsible for providing all testing.* Costs are subsidiary to the delivered stone bid items.
- Is there only one test required? Testing is required for each of the source locations that the contractor chooses to deliver from. Only one set of the applicable tests needs to be run for each source to confirm all the material meets the test criteria per the scope of work and specifications.
- Who needs to perform the test, is there a certain vendor? *Tests maybe performed by any material testing laboratory that are certified by AASHTO.*
