SRA TIMBER MANAGEMENT POLICY

- 1. No tree larger than 3" diameter breast height shall be removed from Authority property without authorization.
- 2. Dead, diseased, or dying trees may be cut and removed from Authority property only with proper authorization.
- 3. All unauthorized cutting, removing or damaging of timber shall be reported to the Division Manager for appropriate action.
- 4. Any Management Program or necessary harvest of Authority timber shall be approved by Board action.
- 5. Any and all unauthorized removal of timber over \$1,500 in value shall be reported to the General Manager for appropriate action.
- 6. The Authority promotes and encourages conservation of all soils against destructive erosion, and where warranted, may re-plant any trees cut, to sustain erosion protection.
- 7. The Authority shall protect, promote and conserve hardwood bottomlands within Authority projects in the interest of conservation and for potential mitigation purposes.
- 8. Periodic inspection of SRA timberlands will be conducted using aerial, land and water approaches.
