L-5 Article 18 (page 65) requires the Licensees, so far as it is consistent with proper operation of the project, to allow the public free access, to a reasonable extent, to project waters and adjacent project

lands owned by the licensees for the purpose of full public utilization of such lands and waters for navigation and outdoor recreation.
